- **Prom tickets go on sale on Monday, March 27 during both lunches. Prices start at \$95 per person through Friday, April 7. Prices go up to \$110 per person starting Monday, April 10 through Friday, April 14. Tickets will NOT be sold after April 14<sup>th</sup>.**
- **A ticket form MUST be completed and submitted at time of ticket purchase.** Ticket forms will be available online via a link sent out through the Junior and Senior eCampus pages, as well as in paper form in the office, Commons, and outside Mrs. Finnegan's room: 8-220. Forms must be submitted in person only - no online submissions.
- **Only OHS Juniors and Seniors may purchase tickets** - by cash or check made out to OHS.
- **Only ONE guest will be permitted per student.**
- **Guest forms for non-OHS students must be submitted and approved ONLINE** prior to purchasing their ticket; a link for the guest form will also be posted online via the Junior and Senior eCampus pages. **Guest forms MUST be received no later than Wednesday, April 12, in order to purchase their ticket.**
- **Students will have reserved seating for dinner and must complete a reservation form for their group no later than Tuesday, April 18.** Reservation forms will be available at the ticket tables in the Commons and outside Mrs. Finnegan's room 8-220. A link to print a copy will also be available on eCampus. Students must have purchased their tickets prior to making a table reservation.

### **First Generation Scholarships to SSC**

I want to briefly introduce myself to you, I am the new Coordinator, First Generation Program at **Seminole State College of Florida**. We have a wonderful **scholarship opportunity** for first generation students.

The **First Generation Program** at Seminole State College is dedicated to assisting students who are *first-generation* (neither parent has earned a bachelor's degree) achieve their goal of earning a college degree. We provide academic advising and financial aid assistance, as well as workshops and activities to help connect you to other students, staff, and faculty –all in one place!

Through a generous donation from the **Wayne M. Densch Charities, Inc.**, we are offering **75 incoming students for Fall 2023** the opportunity to participate in a first generation scholarship program in which we provide a \$750 scholarship each semester (fall and spring, total award up to \$3,000) your first two years at Seminole State College.

Last year we did not award all 75 scholarships as a result of having fewer applicants. This year we are hoping to increase the amount of applicants and award all 75 scholarships. I believe that is possible with your support. **Please share this opportunity with your students and encourage them to apply.**

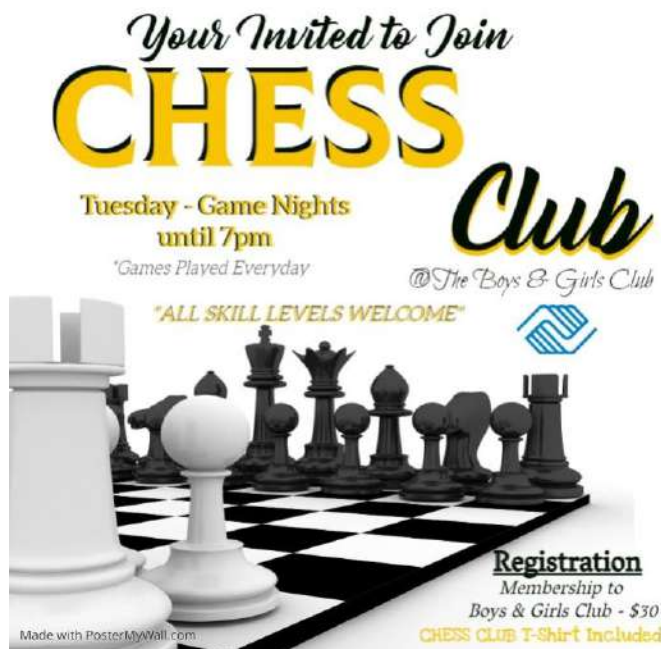

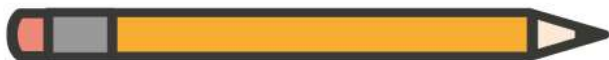

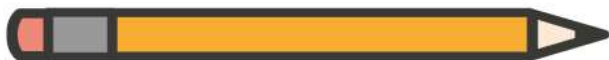
