Are we allowed to decorate our graduation caps? Yes, seniors will be allowed to decorate their caps for graduation! Please take into consideration the following rules when decorating your graduation cap. *Failure to follow these rules will result in the removal of the cap before the ceremony.*

Graduation cap decorations:

- Only the flat, top area of the mortar board may be decorated. There may be nothing hanging down from any sides of the cap. ALL decorations MUST lay FLAT on the cap.
- Cannot contain any advertisements, symbols, abbreviations, words, slogans, patches, or pictures that: refer to drugs or controlled substances, tobacco, alcohol, or weapons or be of a sexual nature.
- Cannot denote an illegal activity, or disruptive behavior which may be detrimental to the safety and welfare of other students.
- Cannot have offensive, obscene, profane, vulgar, or lewd language, sayings, nicknames, pictures, or lyrics.
- Cannot make noise. No bells, horns, whistles, or anything that makes noise.

It is appropriate to put the following on your cap:

- Recognize your post-secondary plans (college, trade school, military, career pursuits)
- Recognize your high school activities (sports, clubs, arts, extra-curricular activities)
- Thank a parent, grandparent, teacher, friend
- Your graduation year
- Include an inspirational message
- Leave it blank. Decoration of your graduation cap is optional

After placing 1st in the Florida Junior Science & Humanities Symposium at the University of Florida and earning a \$2,000 scholarship, **Kyra Henriques** represented Florida (and OHS) in the oral competition at the 61st National Junior Science and Humanities Symposium, organized by the US Department of Defense and held in Virginia Beach, VA, during the week of April 10, 2023. She was one of two Florida delegates in the oral part of the competition. There were

245 students from the 50 US states, Puerto Rico, and DoD schools in Europe and the Pacific.

Kyra showcased her research through a 12-minute presentation of her work and a 6-minute Q&A defense. She received 3rd Place in Oral Presentation (Chemistry), earning a \$4,000 scholarship.

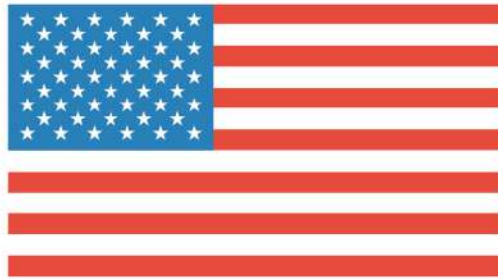

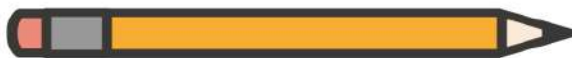

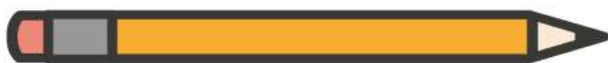
