Alyssa Wahl advanced in the 400m hurdles with a time of 16.65 and Hannah Adamson advances in the 800m with a personal record 2:18.78. Three relay teams advanced. Olivia Jacobus, Hannah Atwell, Maya Cabal and Hannah Adamson ran a season best 9:56.64 to win the District Championship in the 4 x 800m Relay. Myles Egerton, Cairo Vanegas, Davis Alloway and Robert Bellamy advance in the Boys 4x800m relay with a season best 8:17.14. The Boys 4x100m relay team set a new school record as Dallas Johnson, Emiliano Galarza Alex McCoy and Tristen Washington ran 42.51 to advance

Archived Information covered in Previous Principal's Updates that is still Pertinent

Are we allowed to decorate our graduation caps? Yes, seniors will be allowed to decorate their caps for graduation! Please take into consideration the following rules when decorating your graduation cap. <u>Failure to follow these rules will result in the removal of the cap before the ceremony.</u>

Graduation cap decorations:

- Only the flat, top area of the mortar board may be decorated. There may be nothing hanging down from any sides of the cap. ALL decorations MUST lay FLAT on the cap.
- Cannot contain any advertisements, symbols, abbreviations, words, slogans, patches, or pictures that: refer to drugs or controlled substances, tobacco, alcohol, or weapons or be of a sexual nature.
- Cannot denote an illegal activity, or disruptive behavior which may be detrimental to the safety and welfare of other students.
- Cannot have offensive, obscene, profane, vulgar, or lewd language, sayings, nicknames, pictures, or lyrics.
- Cannot make noise. No bells, horns, whistles, or anything that makes noise.

It is appropriate to put the following on your cap:

- Recognize your post-secondary plans (college, trade school, military, career pursuits)
- Recognize your high school activities (sports, clubs, arts, extra-curricular activities)
- Thank a parent, grandparent, teacher, friend
- Your graduation year
- Include an inspirational message
- Leave it blank. Decoration of your graduation cap is optional
