

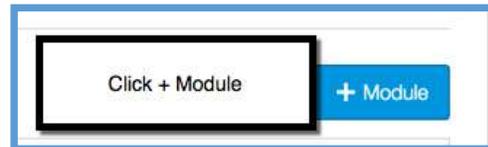

1. In your course create a Module and label the Module DBQ Online.

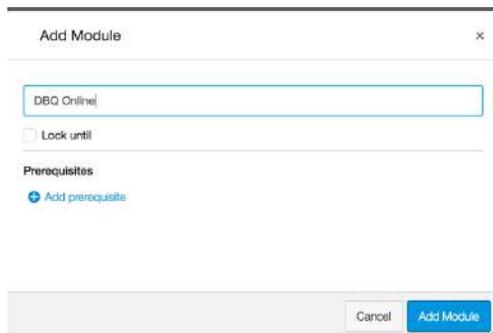
Click on Module



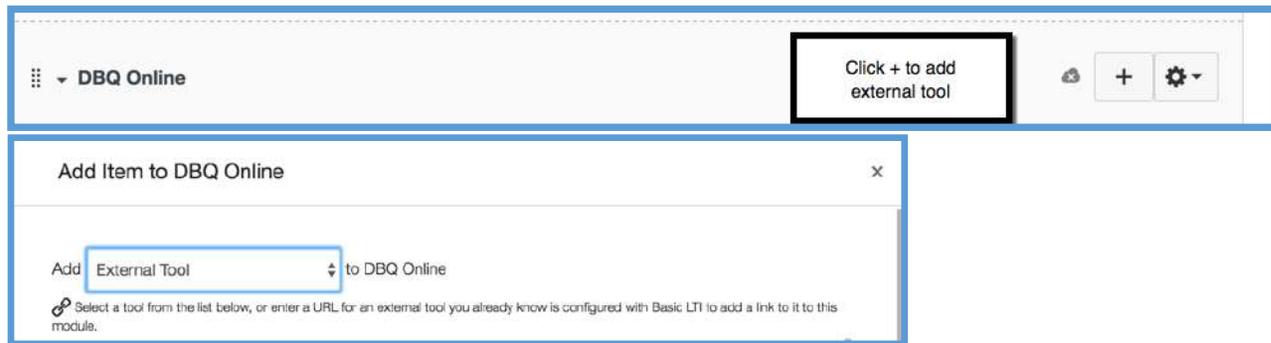
Click + to Add Module

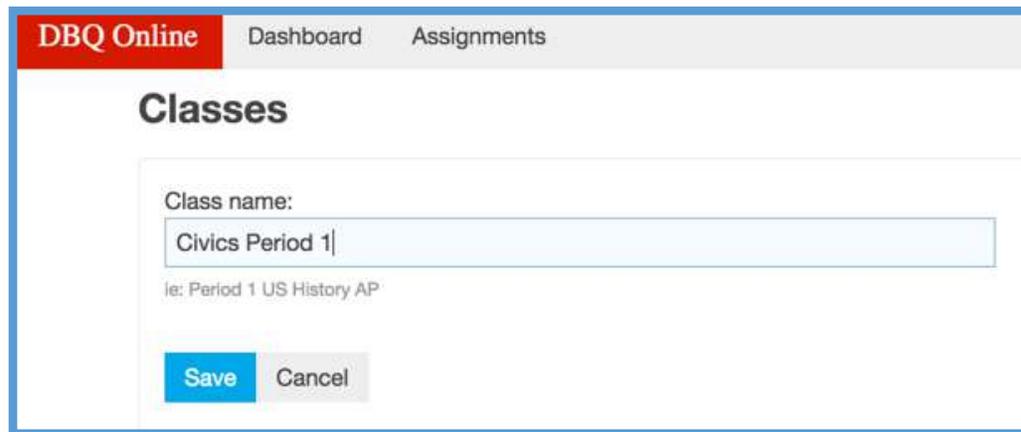
