
The K-12 Delaware Dual Language Immersion **Student Experience**



Delaware Dual Language Immersion programs provide students with a seamless K-12 language and content-learning experience including four components. Each component builds upon the previous to ensure continued growth in both language proficiency and academic content knowledge. Students who complete all four components of the program will be assured of becoming bilingual, biliterate, and able to successfully navigate multiple cultures in multiple contexts, thus being ultimately prepared for college, career, and life.



Program. Students are well-positioned to earn the Delaware Certificate of Multiliteracy in their ninth grade year.

High School Bridge In grades 10-12, immersion continuation students are able to participate in Bridge Program opportunities. In Delaware, a Bridge Program is any course offering that provides students with opportunities to extend their immersion language and content knowledge into college and work environments. Delaware Bridge Programs may include dual-credit/dual-enrollment courses with the University of Delaware or Delaware State University or immersion-specific career pathways.
