

# DUAL ENROLLMENT ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

LHS and each individual college has specific requirements to participate in Dual Enrollment. Students are responsible for completing the admission and registration process with their LHS Counselor and their college advisor.

## Georgia State University

### GPA minimum both campuses:

3.0 GPA as calculated by GSU

### Perimeter Campus

### Test Score Minimums:

SAT - 530 Rdg/Wtg, 530 Math

ACT - 20 Eng or Rdg, 21 Math

Accuplacer – Can be taken in lieu of the SAT/ACT

### Test Score Minimums:

SAT - 580 Rdg/Wtg, 560 Math

ACT - 23 Eng or Rdg, 23 Math

Placement test required for any math class higher than Math 1111

PSAT - 23 Rdg, 24 Wtg, 22 Math

ACT - 16 Eng, 19 Math, 17 Rdg

SAT - 25 Rdg, 26 Wrtg, 24 Math

Accuplacer- Accuplacer will only be administered for those students that have no qualifying scores or need to meet a higher test score to participate in a program.

### Communication:

Student must use personal email account (not school account) for application and are required to then use college email account and student portal.

### Student Orientation:

Required to be completed online before student can register or attend classes.
