

## What is Dual Enrollment?

Dual enrollment is an acceleration program that allows students in high school to take postsecondary coursework at Pasco Hernando State College (PHSC). Students simultaneously earn credits toward high school completion and a college degree or certification.

Most courses are taken at PHSC with a few offerings available on Anclote's campus. A student must provide his or her own transportation to PHSC

### Importance of Dual Enrollment courses

- Courses are weighted on a 5 point scale (A=5, B=4, C=3, D=2, F=0)
- Earn college credit at the same time as high school credit
- Advanced courses look impressive on a transcript



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## Classes at PHSC

Students can take a variety of dual enrollment courses from academics to electives. Most students take their courses at PHSC, however some courses are available on line as well.

Students must access phsc.edu to make sure they have met the appropriate test scores as well as any prerequisite that is required. **If a class that a student wants to take is offered at Anclote, the student must take the course at Anclote.**

### Minimum Test Requirements

	ACT	PERT	SAT(prior to 3/16)	SAT(3/16 and beyond)
Reading	19	106	440	24
Writing	17	103	440	25
Math	19/21	114/123	440/490	24/26

- If a student passes the reading and English sections but does not achieve college ready math score, the student can only take a maximum of 12 college credits as a dual enrollment student.

### Eligibility Guidelines

- Student must be enrolled in Anclote and have a high school cumulative unweighted GPA of a 3.0 or higher
- 10<sup>th</sup> grade students may access courses on a PHSC campus up to a maximum of 7 credit hours per semester. In addition, they may access DE courses on the high school campus for a combined maximum of 16 credit hours per semester. 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students may take up to 16 credit hours per semester of DE coursework.
- Appropriate test scores
- Students must have approval from their parent or legal guardian
- A student must earn at least a "C" in a DE course in order to enroll in the next level of the course.

### Steps to Take

#### Dual Enrollment Classes

1. Earn a cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA
2. Complete PHSC Application for Admission
3. Provide passing ACT/SAT or PERT scores
4. Meet with your grade level counselor
5. Select courses using phsc.edu
6. Fill out appropriate paperwork
7. Maintain a high school cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA and a PHSC GPA of 2.0
8. Follow all Drop/Add deadlines for Anclote and PHSC
