You can register for the SAT at <a href="www.collegeboard.com">www.collegeboard.com</a>. You can register for the ACT at <a href="www.actstudent.org">www.actstudent.org</a>. A major credit/debit card is required for you to register online. All colleges/universities require you to have an SAT or an ACT score when you complete college applications; so you need to go ahead and register to take the test soon!!! Do not procrastinate! If you have any additional questions, refer to your senior planning packet or visit the counseling office.

#### **UPCOMING SENIOR ACTIVITIES/EVENTS**

FINANCIAL AID WORKSHOP: A financial aid workshop will be held on *Monday, January 27, 2014 at 6:30 p.m. in the Henry County High School Performing Arts Center*. This workshop will cover financial aid topics such as completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), HOPE Scholarship, and other pertinent information. This should be a very informative workshop for parents who are anticipating having a freshman in college during the 2014-2015 school year. The FAFSA is the main financial aid application that must be completed to determine all sources of financial aid. The application becomes available after January 1. It is strongly recommended that parents complete their 2013 income tax return as soon as possible because the information will be necessary to complete this federal application. All parents should complete this application even if you do not think that your child will be able to receive financial aid. In the past, this workshop has been poorly attended by HCHS senior parents. We are trying to bridge the communication gap to make sure that our parents are informed. Please make plans to attend! In February, our parent involvement coordinator will host a workshop that will allow parents to get additional help in completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid. More information is forthcoming regarding this helpful workshop.

**SCHOLARSHIPS**: During the holidays, we strongly encourage students to continue to work on scholarship applications. The December scholarship directory is attached for your convenience. We have several scholarship applications in the counseling office. There are very few seniors who have been picking up these applications. It takes work to get scholarships; however, it pays off if it helps to reduce tuition costs. Tuition hikes for Georgia public colleges and universities are anticipated for Fall 2014. Students should take advantage of all of the financial aid resources that are available to help offset rising tuition costs. The scholarship directory is posted on the counseling webpage and was also sent in the December senior monthly e-mail blast.

<u>CREDIT RECOVERY</u>: All students who are taking or need to complete credit recovery with Mr. Harvey must continue to work to stay on track to complete the course that you are trying to make-up. Remember, this is a FREE opportunity for you to make up courses. If you have not already registered to complete a credit recovery course, you need to see Mr. Harvey ASAP. This is your responsibility!!! Do not wait until the last minute to do what is necessary for you to fulfill graduation requirements.

#### REMINDERS

If you made a down payment on a yearbook you must pay your remaining balance by December 20. If not, your balance will increase as the price of the book increases. The yearbook is currently \$60 and will increase to \$65 on January 1. The deadline to have your yearbook engraved with your name is January 7, 2014. The cost is \$6 extra.
