




#### TEACHERS

- ❖ EARLY FALL, REACHED OUT TO DISTRICT STAFF ABOUT REQUESTING A TRANSFER TO EITHER ALLIANCE ACADEMY OR DENMARK HIGH SCHOOL
- ❖ WINDOW STILL OPEN TO REQUEST A TRANSFER
- ❖ Internal interviews will be held in November and December
- ❖ INTERVIEWS FOR TEACHERS OUTSIDE FORSYTH COUNTY BEGIN IN JANUARY
- ❖ TEACHERS WILL BE ADDED TO DENMARK STAFF IN WAVES, BEGINNING WITH DEPARTMENT CHAIRS


