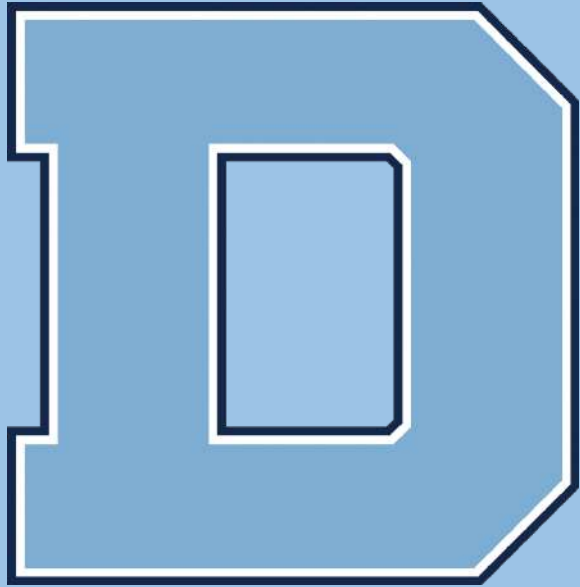

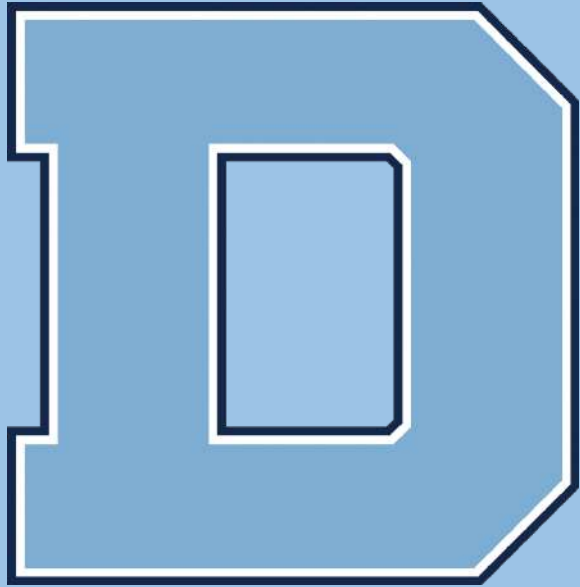

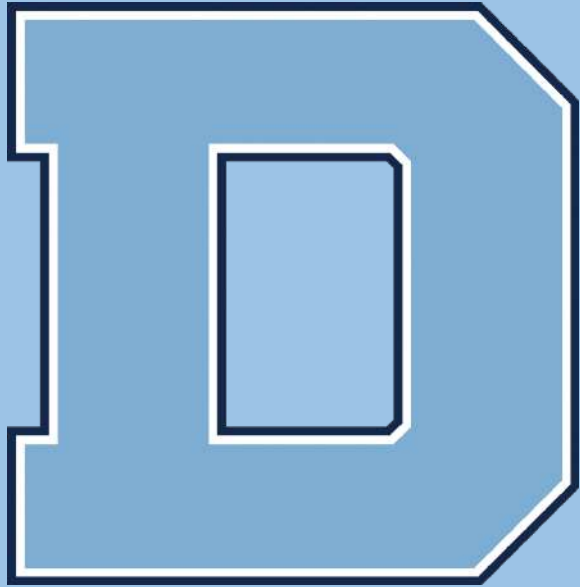

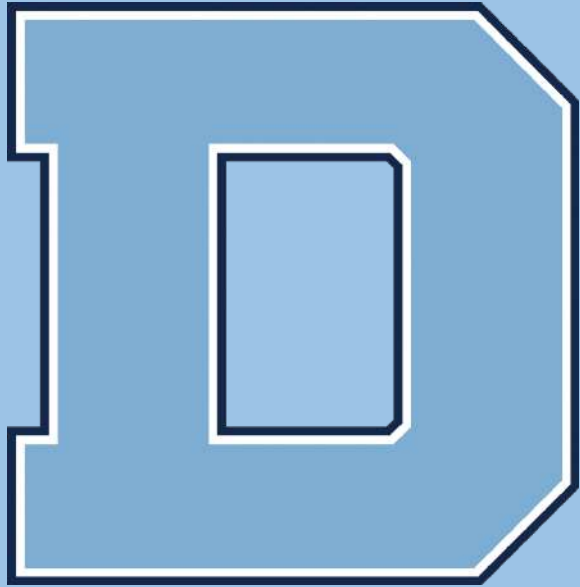

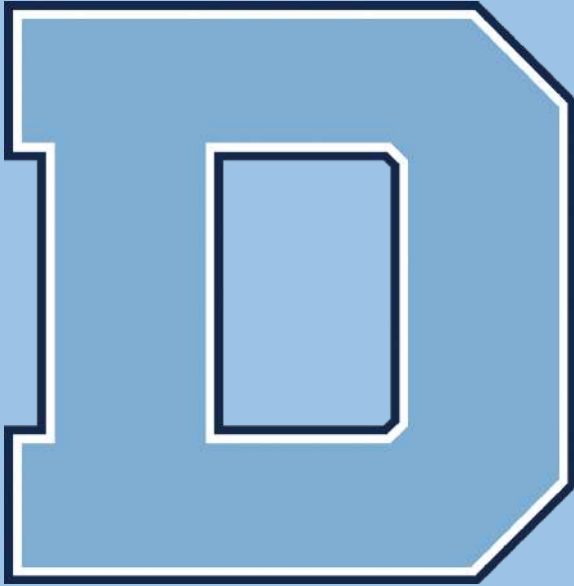
TEACHERS

- ❖ WINDOW STILL OPEN TO REQUEST A TRANSFER
- ❖ INTERNAL INTERVIEWS WILL BE HELD IN NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER
- ❖ INTERVIEWS FOR TEACHERS OUTSIDE FORSYTH COUNTY BEGIN IN JANUARY
- ❖ TEACHERS WILL BE ADDED TO DENMARK STAFF IN WAVES, BEGINNING WITH DEPARTMENT CHAIRS
