The SNHS is an honor society bestowed upon students enrolled in the 11th or 12th grade. The requirements for membership include the following:

- A member must have and maintain a 3.0 grade point average across all classes and a 3.5 GPA across all sciences.
- A member must be enrolled in at least one honors level science class during or prior to the eleventh-grade year. A member must be enrolled in at least one second year honors science class during or prior to the twelfth-grade year. A member must be enrolled in at least one upper level science class during the twelfth-grade year. If second year honors or upper level science courses are not offered by the school, then the student must be enrolled in a second first year honors or upper level science class.
- A member must maintain a B cumulative average (3.50/4.00) across each science course.
- A member must maintain behavior that is acceptable to the guidelines as outlined by the school's code of conduct in the student handbook of their educational institution.
- All members must attend one local chapter officer's lecture annually. All lectures must be approved by the chapter's advisor before being presented.
- Regular members may give a lecture with the chapter advisor's approval.
- Any active member who falls below the standard of 3.00/4.00 G.P.A or who falls below a 3.50/4.00 average across all science courses shall be placed on probation for the interim of one **grading** period. A 3.00/4.00 in overall G.P.A. and a 3.500/4.00 average across all science courses will be the standard that is mandated for students. The member will then be given one grading period to correct the deficiency. If the standards fail to be met, the student shall be dropped from membership in the Science National Honor Society.

CHAPTER ACTIVITIES

- Each chapter shall determine one or more projects per year.
- All members shall participate in one or more of the chapter's projects per year.
- The purpose of the projects shall be to encourage scientific and intellectual thought, to further the knowledge of science in school and community, and to volunteer in the surrounding community.
- Each chapter shall either judge or host a local science fair contest and/or assist in the creation and/or maintenance of a science club at the school and/or assist fellow students' success in their science classes.
- Members must complete four hours of service per school year to keep their membership.
- Chapters shall also attempt to bring speakers from the scientific community into the school to the extent to which their resources and location allow.

- Only **complete** applications received by the deadline will be considered.
- Application deadline is Monday, September 14, 2020 at 4:00pm
- All applications must be turned in to Shelby Cochran, room 1614 OR by email if virtual
- Accepted members will be notified by letter of acceptance on September 28, 2020.
- If accepted, membership fees (\$20) are due by October 9, 2020 on MyPaymentsPlus.
