Acquire 23 Academic Access (or equivalent) and CTAE course credits, participate in 8 <sup>th</sup> grade Georgia Alternate Assessment (GAA), pass the GAA in 11 <sup>th</sup> grade and graduate at the age of 22 or if under age 22, graduate with confirmed employment and support services.	Student meets eligibility for the HS GAA but did not participate in the 8 <sup>th</sup> grade GAA (these students have the opportunity to appeal to the state to request the Regular Access Diploma) OR Student does not meet GAA/Access Requirements as determined by state guidelines but is participating in a modified curriculum. <i>Student must agree to requirements on page 3.</i>
