Assignments and daily directions will be posted here. Assignments can be turned in, graded and commented on here. Students can take quizzes here. Work can be saved in the "Back Pack". Students can log in outside of the classroom as well. As long as there is internet access, students have access to Edmodo. There is even a downloadable app, which I recommend students use. Another great feature is that you, the parent, can link directly into your child's account. On the attached sheets, I have included the simple directions for creating an Edmodo Parent and Student account. If you have the capability, please connect to your child's account. 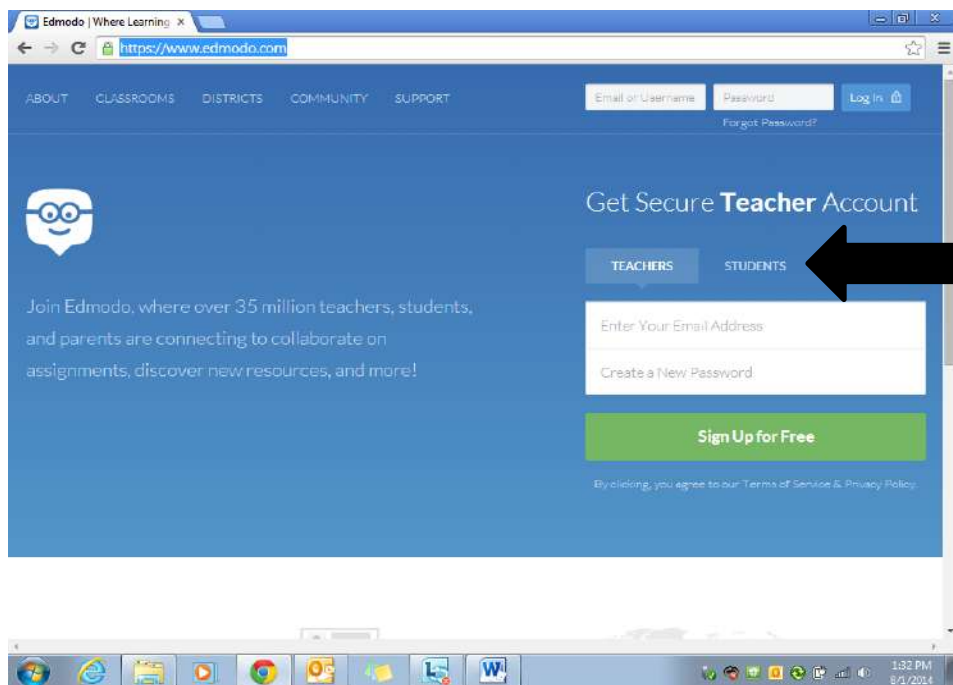

## Directions on how to set up a student account on Edmodo

In order to create a student account, students must have the Group Code for their specific class. This is a 6 character code provided at the top of this page. Once you have this code, please follow the directions below:

On the Edmodo sign in page, click the Students tab



It will open up a page where you can create a Student Account.

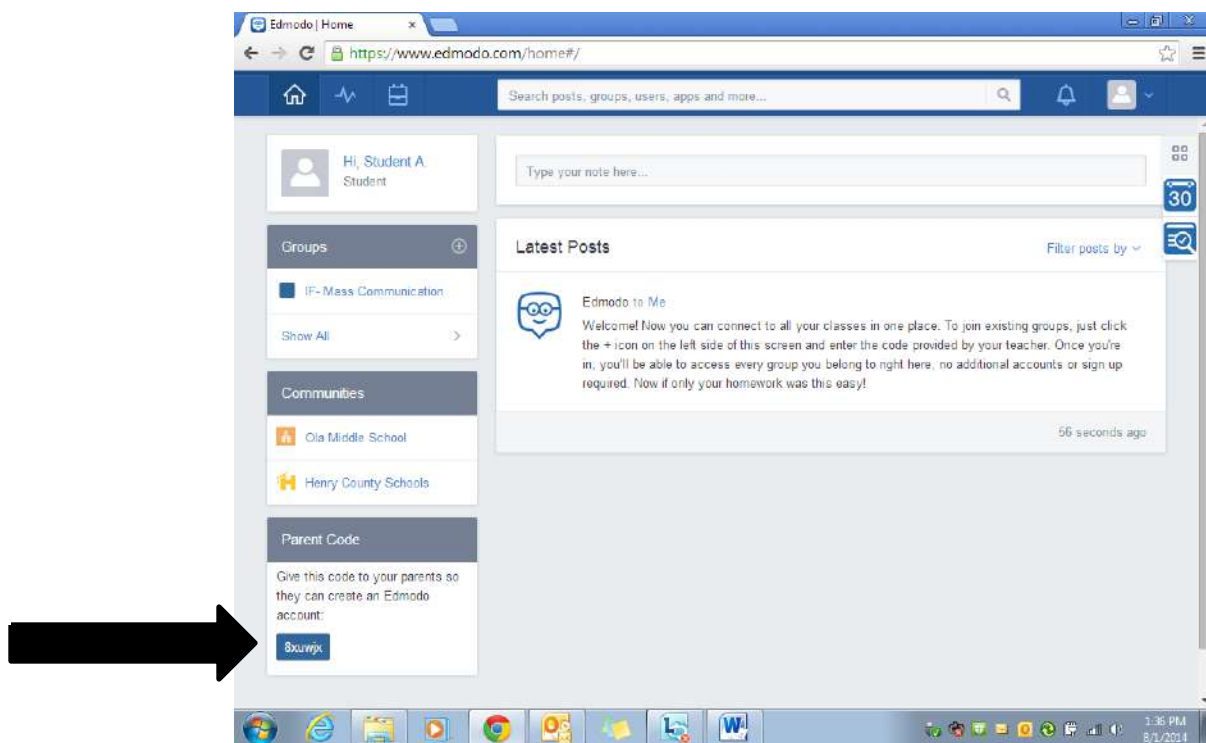

Students need to fill in each line with the provided Group Code for his or her class, first and last name and create a username and password. It is recommended that students choose a username and password that he/she will not easily forget and that it is written down. Please make sure that first and last name begin with a capital letter. You should pay attention to when each line is filled in. A green check mark will appear if the group code is correct and the username has not been used. If the username has been taken, a red warning box will appear on the left. You must choose a different name. Please be careful when using capital letters in usernames and passwords. Log ins ARE case sensitive. Be sure to write your log in information down EXACTLY as you created it. Once all information is given the "Green Checks", click "Sign Up For Free". When your account has been created, it will take you straight to your

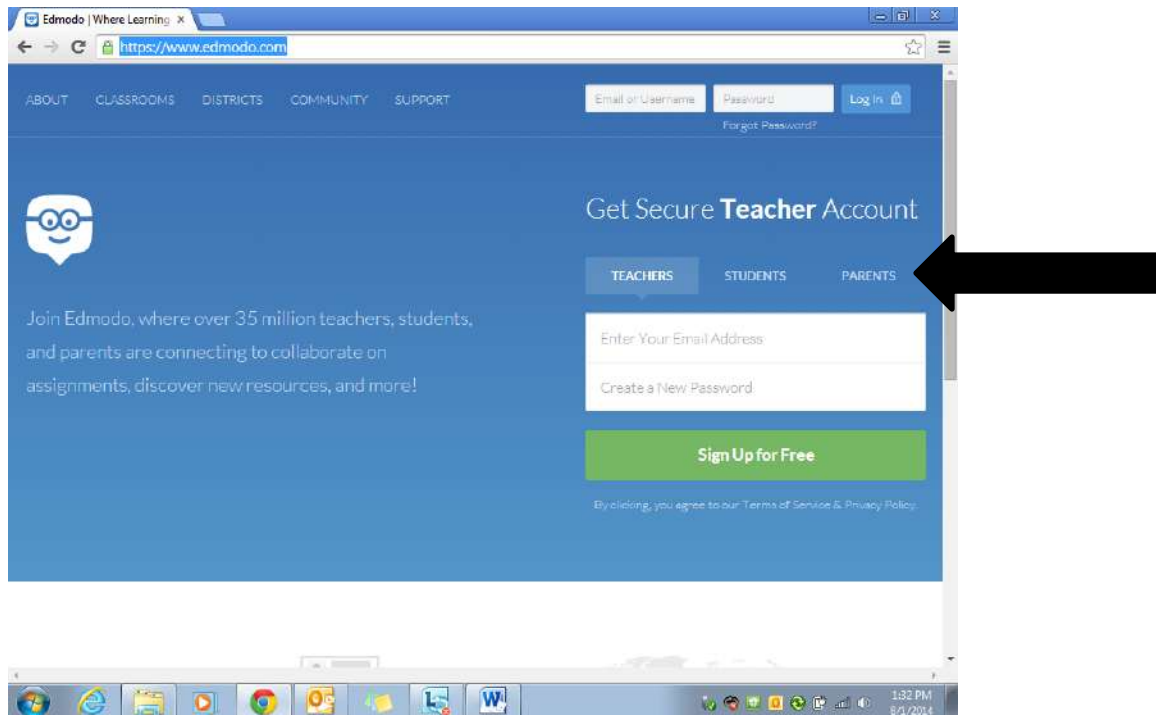
class period wall. Once you are there, directions will be there for you to follow.

### Directions on how to set up a parent account on Edmodo

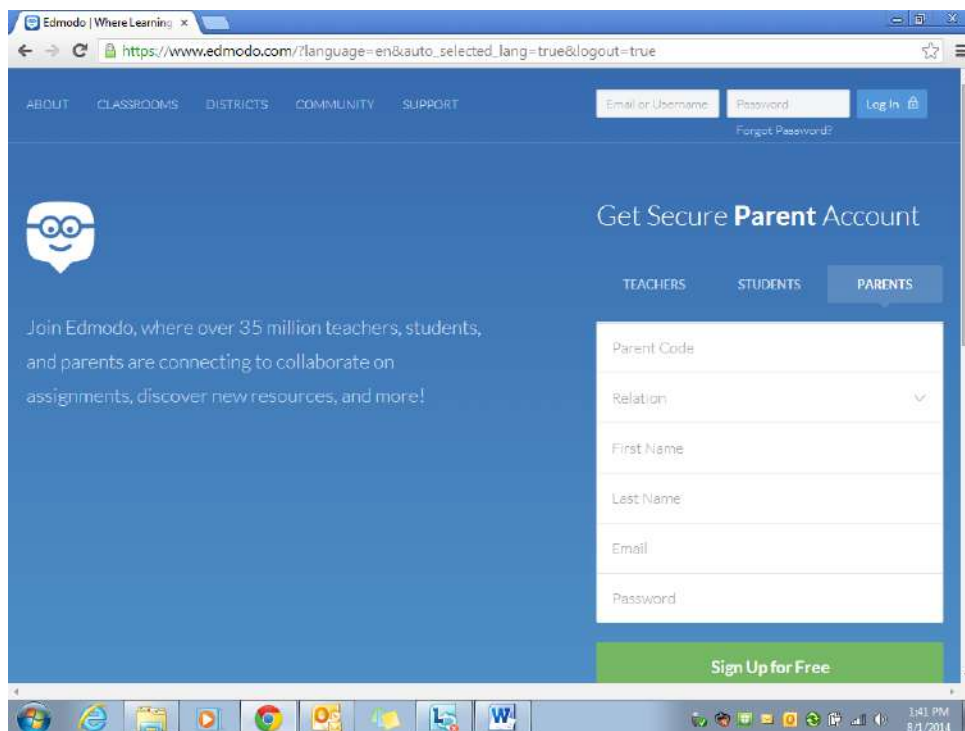
In order to connect to your child's Edmodo page, your child must have created an Edmodo account first. When you and your child log into his or her account, please write down the Parent Code that is located on the bottom left hand corner of your child's home screen. This personalized code will link you straight to your child's account. Please log out after you have the code.



On the Edmodo sign in page, click the Parents tab.



It will open up a page where you can create a Parent Account.



Fill in the Parent Code that you wrote down from your child's home page as well as your relationship, first name, last name, email and password. Then click Sign Up for Free.

When you are linked to your child's account, you are able to see what is going on in our class. All posts, grades and progress are all available to you. You can also add other children to your account if they have signed up for Edmodo as well.
