We pride ourselves at Otwell Middle School for having students with exemplary behavior. However, in the event of inappropriate behaviors, the eighth grade teachers would like to count on your support in reinforcing the importance of each student's responsibility for his/her own learning. In an effort to better communicate with you and keep up with each individual student, we will use a mark card system to document inappropriate behaviors. Each student will have his/her own conduct card stapled to the inside front cover of the agenda that will be used to monitor discipline and responsibility. Expectations for our students are listed below, as well as consequences for inappropriate behaviors. In addition, students will receive rewards at the end of each grading period for exhibiting excellent behavior. Students receive a NEW discipline card with zero conduct marks at the beginning of each new 9 weeks and have the chance to start with a

clean slate.

- 1.) Be on time to class
- 2.) Follow the directions of the teacher and/or substitute teacher
- 3.) No cell phones, iPods, cameras, or other electronic devices are allowed in class
- 4.) Be prepared and bring all of your supplies to class everyday
- 5.) Be respectful of others...administrators, teachers, and fellow students

Disciplinary Consequences for Inappropriate Behaviors (based on marks on the Conduct Card):

- Step 1 Verbal warning and/or silent lunch
- Step 2 Student/teacher(s) conference (3 marks)
- Step 3 Parent contact (5 marks)

- Step 4 Morning/afternoon detention (8 marks)
- Step 5 Off-team suspension (11 marks)
- Step 6 Office referral (15 marks)

*If a card is lost, the student will be issued a second card with five marks already on it. If the lost card is found, it goes back in the agenda replacing the new one.

Automatic office referrals are given to students for actions such as fighting, cheating, disrespect to teachers, skipping class, harassment, illegal substances (drugs, alcohol, etc.), weapons, and repeat cell phone violations. Teachers reserve the right to assign immediate consequences such as detention and silent lunch for certain behaviors or actions. Inappropriate behavior may result in loss of field trip privileges.

A new discipline card will be given at the beginning of each nine weeks.
