



Helpful Lesson Plan Tips

Helpful Tips

- Wherever you see a blue link, click on it. This is a hyperlink to an assignment, document, video, etc.
- If you see a link with “hnh”, you as the parent will not be able to access it. This is our digital textbook, and only the scholar has access to the textbook.
- When completing an assignment, please be sure your scholar clicks the Submit button! Many scholars think they’ve turned an assignment in, but haven’t clicked “Submit” to send it to his/her teacher. If the assignment shows missing in Infinite Campus, but the scholar has clicked the Submit button, open the assignment to be sure the work is completed. Sometimes scholars submit blank documents.
- Scan the plans for the Graded Assignments column. This will help your scholar to plan for the week with his/her due dates.
- Check your Infinite Campus Parent Portal at least once per week to track your scholar’s progress of graded assignments.
- Provide your scholar with a planner/agenda to organize and keep track of assignment due dates.
