The Grizzlies also earned accolades for <u>AP Merit School</u>, <u>AP Honor School</u>, <u>AP STEM School</u>, <u>AP STEM Achievement School and an AP Humanities School</u>.

When you couple all of these items with our success in our extra-curricular areas of fine arts, JROTC (our Rangers captured another state title), clubs and GHSA sponsored athletic programs- in which each of our fall teams (softball, volleyball, cross country and football) made the state playoffs, it truly is "Great To Be A Grizzly!"
