1. **YOU GET TO CHOOSE WHICH 26 WORDS YOU WANT TO DO FROM THE SCOPE OF BIOLOGY, SCIENTIFIC METHOD, ANIMAL BEHAVIOR, CELL CHEMISTRY AND CELL STRUCTURE AND FUNCTION CHAPTERS IN YOUR TEXTBOOK.(CHAPTERS 1-6)**
2. **YOU CAN DO THE BOOK IN POWERPOINT (EACH PAGE WOULD BE A SLIDE), OR YOU CAN MAKE IT YOURSELF**

REQUIREMENTS THAT MUST BE MET!!!!

* You are required to pick from **KEY TERMS AND/OR WORDS WE DISCUSSED IN CLASS**. Any **OTHER WORDS** will NOT COUNT.

*Each page must include:

- a. the letter you are illustrating
- b. the word
- c. a definition
- d. a short Seuss-like Rhyme which ties in with the definition
- e. a picture (you can draw it, cut it out from another source, or insert a picture from the web) If you use borrowed illustrations, you must include a works cited page for them.

These pictures must be colorful for full credit!!

RUBRIC:

26 pts for the 26 letters with the word you chose to represent them. (Note: if you cannot find a word that starts with that letter of the alphabet from Ch. 10-15, then highlight that letter in the middle of the word. For example: conVergent eVolution

may be used for the letter "V".)

10 pts for the definitions (in your own SIMPLE words)

25 pts for the rhymes

20 pts for the pictures

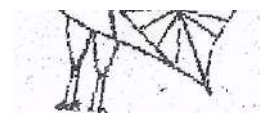
20 pts for creativity.... a bound, neat, & attractive
