

Dual Enrollment Admission

Requirements Changes Due to COVID-19

Due to the decision made by the University System of Georgia to waive test score requirements for Spring, Summer, and Fall 2021 admission due to uncertainty about the scheduling of SAT/ACT testing during the COVID-19 pandemic, Dual Enrollment (DE) applicants are able to apply to colleges within the University System of GA without SAT, ACT, or Accuplacer scores. However, the new DE rules/legislation require 10th grade students to meet testing requirements. **9th grade students are not eligible for DE.** DE updates/information can be found at <https://www.gafutures.org/hope-state-aid-programs/scholarships-grants/dual-enrollment/>. <u>Gordon State College</u> Apply for DE at https://gordonstate-uga.edu/185r.net/application/login/index.php?id=1 (No application fee)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must have a 3.0 HOPE GPA (visit www.gafutures.org or check with your counselor to obtain your HOPE GPA) Must be a junior/senior during the 2020-21 school year. 10th graders must have a 1200 SAT or 26 ACT.
<u>Southern Crescent Technical College</u> Check with your counselor for a DE admission application. SCTC prefers a 2.6 HOPE GPA, but will accept a 2.0 cumulative GPA due to the COVID-19 pandemic.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must have a 2.6 HOPE GPA (visit www.gafutures.org or check w/your counselor to obtain your HOPE GPA) Must be a junior/senior during the 2020-21 school year. 10th graders must have a 1200 SAT or 26 ACT or take an approved CTAE course at a participating TCSG institution only.

***All eligible 10th Graders may enroll in approved Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE) courses listed on the Course Directory at a participating TCSG institution only.**

***10th Graders who have a minimum SAT score of 1200 or minimum ACT composite score of 26 in a single national test administration, may enroll in any approved courses listed on the course directory at a TCSG, USG or private eligible participating postsecondary institution.**

***9th grade students are not eligible to participate in dual enrollment**

First Steps for students interested in dual enrollment for spring, summer, and fall 2021 semesters:

- E-mail your high school counselor to virtually discuss Dual Enrollment (DE) opportunities.
- Once you have made contact with your counselor to discuss your plans/academic standing for DE, please access the application admissions link above for the college/university of your choice. You will have to request for a transcript to be sent to the college/university from your high school and any additional information that may be requested by the college/university.
- Remember, the testing requirement suspension is temporary. However, the new DE rules/legislation require 10th grade students to have the required test scores as listed above. Students should still plan to take the ACT/SAT and/or ACCUPLACER once those opportunities are available again. Students who have already taken these tests may still submit them.
