Dear Stockbridge High School Students and Parents:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with important information concerning the upcoming final exam schedule. Even though it seems as if the school year has just begun, the end of the year is fast approaching. Final exams are scheduled for May 24, 2021 and May 25, 2021. To ensure the best possible environment, students will **not** be permitted to check-out while exams are being administered. Classroom interruptions and students in the hallway make it very difficult to maintain a positive testing environment. Please note that exams will end **early** on Monday, May 24th and Tuesday, May 25th. Students who have completed and turned in their early release check-out form to the Attendance Office **before May 21<sup>st</sup>** must leave campus at 12:21 P.M. **There will be no bus transportation for students that check-out early on Monday, May 24<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday, May 25<sup>th</sup>.** Students that will **not** be checking out early will return to their Exam 2 classroom for the remainder of the day. **Bus transportation will only be provided on Wednesday, May 26<sup>th</sup>.**

**Early exams are not permitted.** Students who have excused absences through prior approval from the Principal will be required to complete their exams on Wednesday, May 26, 2021 starting at 8:30 A.M. **May 26th is the ONLY make-up day for exams.** If a student is ill on an exam day, it is the parent's responsibility to contact the Principal **prior** to 8:20 A.M. to make arrangements for the student to complete their finals on Wednesday, May 26, 2021, starting at 8:30 A.M. Please note that the questions on the make-up exams will not be the same as those given during the regularly scheduled exam days.

**\*\*Students who arrive at school after 8:15 A.M. on exam days may not be admitted to their first exam of that day.**
