

ECONOMIC SYSTEMS FOLDABLE

(EVERYTHING YOU NEED IS IN THE NOTES ON SYSTEMS!)

TO MAKE THE FOLDABLE: Fold a piece of paper horizontally, leaving about ½” overlapping for tabs. Fold the paper in half and then into half again. Cut the top later into four flaps.

FRONT/LABELING:

1. Label each tab: traditional, command, market, mixed.
2. Draw/print out an image for the front of each flap. Images must be in color and relate to the system for that flap.





INSIDE:

1. Compare the systems with regard to private ownership, profit motive, consumer sovereignty, competition, & government regulation. Number these 1-5 and list on the inside back of the flap.
2. Evaluate how well each system answers the three basic questions: What is produced? How is it produced? For whom is it produced? Number these 1-3.
3. Explain how well each system meets the broad goals of economic freedom, security, equity, growth, efficiency & stability. Number these 1-6 and place on the bottom of the inside section.
