Did You Know?


The purpose of the EdInsight Dashboard is to enable data-driven decision making throughout the education system that will ultimately result in improved outcomes for Delaware students. The EdInsight Dashboard was developed for teachers, principals, and district administrators.

The EdInsight Dashboard is designed to:

- Logically and intuitively relate data that is fragmented across multiple systems and make it accessible with in a few clicks
- Used as a tool to measure where active students are 'today' in relationship to metrics, thresholds and goals
- Drive PLC discussion and encourage users to look at the entire data portfolio of a student
- Provide research-based indicators to quickly focus the user on individuals or groups needing the most attention
- Display data in a userfriendly format and easily accessible on all Internet platforms by any device

The EdInsight Dashboard was not designed as a detailed analysis or research tool. It has been designed to quickly help identify areas where additional analysis and research might be useful.

The EdInsight Dashboard allows a teacher to see longitudinal educational data no matter where their students previously attended. Educational Data such as daily attendance, class attendance, total days absent, tardy to school, discipline incidents, State & Local Assessment scores, PSAT, SAT & AP Exam Scores, Classroom Failing Grades, Classroom Grades C or Below, Enrollment History, Online Transcript and Student Program Enrollment is easily accessed on the EdInsight Dashboard system.






Smarter Balanced Assessment Data for the Building Administrator

As part of the Race to the Top initiative, the Delaware Department of Education (DDOE) developed a comprehensive dashboard system which is free of charge to all Delaware Public and Charter School users.

This project is leveraged on the public domain design documentation developed by the Michael and Susan Dell Foundation for the Texas Education Agency, and incorporated results from Delaware Public and Charter school interviews conducted in the Fall of 2010.

The EdInsight Dashboard allows a Building Administrator the ability to view currently enrolled students and the percent of students meeting proficiency. The status is green if the school is above the state average, and red if the school falls below the state average. The 'More' drilldown has two options: Grade Level Chart which displays the % of students by achievement level and by grade and a Student List with all students who received a AL1 or AL2.
