Rigorous Accelerated Math Pathways for Elementary Students (RAMP) is available for mathematically talented students in grades 4 through 5.



Technology and the Future



- Students are introduced to new technologies and activities designed to build their problemsolving, logical thinking, and collaboration skills.
- At English Estates Elementary, STEM activities are integrated into all grade level Math & Science instruction and during Specials rotations.
- Computer Science 2020 Our students participate in at least 10 hours of computer science learning each school year.

Student Achievement 2021-2022 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady
 progress monitoring. 65% of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and 60% of K5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **59%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.

English Estates Elementary School earned a C grade from the Florida DOE in 2022

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- All students at English Estates Elementary have an opportunity to obtain Leadership Roles.
- English Estates Elementary received the Five Star & Golden School Award.
- We offer a variety of clubs: Encore, Bucket Drummers, Games Club, Art Club, Weaving Club, Running Club, & Garden Club
- Our PTA continues to be recognized at the State and District level for award winning programs.
- Kindness Club volunteers mentor our students each week and provide a bag of non-perishable food items.
- English Estates Dividends contributed 8,255 hours of their time to support our students.
