2019 AP EXAM TESTING INFORMATION

- All payments for the AP given to Mrs. Williams in the Counseling Office.
- ELHS students taking AP Exams will complete the pre-administration bubbling process before 3 May 2019 when they will receive their AP Student Pack and testing ID.
- All testing will take place in the ROTC Rifle Range Area. Students need to be on-time. No students will be admitted into the testing area after the test has started.
- Students taking an AM AP Exam will report directly to the testing location at the beginning of school. Students taking a PM AP Exam will eat first lunch and report directly to the testing location.
- Students must arrive at the testing location on time and prepared to take the AP Exam. Students should bring water and a snack for mid-Exam break, two sharpened No. 2 pencils with erasers, two pens with black or blue ink, up to two approved calculators (for Biology, Calculus, Physics, and Statistics).
- Students taking AP Exams are excused from other classes for the day. Those taking AM AP Exams may leave after testing; those taking PM AP Exams may arrive on campus at 11:25 a.m. for testing.
- Students taking afternoon exam, must have their own transportation home. Afternoon test could extend after 3:15 PM.
