Eliminating Incorrect Answer Choices

When an answer choice is *obliviously* incorrect, it doesn't connect to the question being asked. All you have to do is R.E.A.D to eliminate the incorrect answer choices and find your final answer.

Read the question and all answer choices carefully

Eliminate any incorrect answer choices

Ask yourself: Is this answer connected to the question?

Determine your final answer.

Eliminate means to remove or get rid of. To eliminate answers, look for:

- Choices not found in the text
- Choices unrelated to the question
- Choices that appear out of place



If you answer yes, you can look for more evidence and move on to determine if this is your final answer choice.

If you answer **no**, you may need to take a step back and eliminate the answer choice.
