ROYAL KNIGHTS HAVE SOME OF THE TOP SAT SCORES IN GEORGIA

Clayton County Public Schools (CCPS) students who took the SAT at CDHS, *Elite Scholars Academy*, FPHS, MZHS, MMHS and MESSOTA in 2022, **outperformed their district counterparts who took the test in 2021**, improving each school's composite score on the standardized test. The results were released Wednesday, September 28th, by the College Board and the Georgia Department of Education (GaDOE).

Elite Scholars Academy led the district with a composite score of 1099. The 2022 score represents a 14-point increase over the 2021 composite, which was 71 points higher than national average (1028) and 47 points higher than Georgia Public School (1052) score.
