Support For EL Learners

 - Georgia is a member of the WIDA Consortium. All members of the WIDA Consortium utilize the same screeners to assess eligibility for language assistance services.
- Henry County uses the WIDA-ACCESS Placement Test (W-APT).

Support For ESOL

- Current EL students who are receiving ESOL services at our school may also qualify for Supplemental Services through our Title 1 Program
- Students who did not score above a 4.3 on their most recent WIDA Screener will receive additional support through Title 1
