- Must show work, not just the answer.

QUIZZES AND TESTS

- **Students may retake any summative assessment in order to improve their overall level of mastery of the concept.**
- **Students must either schedule a time during AIR - Time or complete additional online assignments to receive remediation and provide evidence that they have increased in their level of mastery of the concept.**
- **Better of the grades will count towards final grade.**

Zoom Etiquette

Be On Time

Sit at a desk or table, preferably in a quiet, well lit area.


Must wear appropriate clothing.
