# GRADING POLICIES

- **If you were failing at Q3 and Q4, you will receive an incomplete**
  - **Student will receive an invitation for Summer Recovery**
- **If a Senior receives an incomplete and cannot complete summer recovery, he/she will be retained**
- **9-Week Courses – Students that fail a 9-week course will be invited to Impact Summer School or to re-enroll in the class**
