Make-up Work

Make-up work is defined as work missed during an excused absence. Students have **2 class days** for each day missed to request and make-up work. Exceptions may be made for extended absences.

Students who are required to miss multiple days due to covid-19 quarantine will have access to the curriculum through their myLearning account (under myPascoConnect). They will be responsible for completing assignments given for that time period and should communicate with the teacher should they have any questions.

Late Work Policy

- 1 Day Late= 15% off
- 2 Days Late= 30% off
- 3+ Days Late= Not accepted unless approved by teacher.

Discipline
