


- The country of Spain is on the Iberian Peninsula.

#### The Italian Peninsula


- Italy is on the Italian Peninsula. It extends into the Mediterranean Sea.

- Language=English









### The Chunnel

# Belgium


- Location = Between France and Germany

- Language = Polish






#### Ukraine


Location = Between Russia and Poland

- A. In Northern Europe there is Tundra and Subarctic climates.
- B. Most of Western Europe has a Marine West Coast climate zone.
- C. Southern Europe has a Mediterranean climate.

### Climate

- Wind currents and ocean currents have a large impact on the climate of Europe.
- A. The North Atlantic Drift is an ocean current that warms Europe.
- B. Europe is also warmed by wind currents called the Westerlies.
