### All Year:

**Skills that should be reinforced:** stamp, glue, fold, tear, cut, chalk, crayon, watercolor, marker, pencil, tempera paint

### **Safety and Respect**

**Concepts:** real and imaginary subject matter, abstract and realistic, knowing the seven Elements of Art, introduction to Principles of Design, Sculpture, introduction artwork from other Cultures

### **Vocabulary:**

- Kindergarten – First Quarter:
  - **Line:** vertical, horizontal, diagonal, zigzag, wavy, thick, thin, curved, outline
  - **Shape:** organic (free form shape), geometric, square, triangle, circle, oval, two-dimensional (flat)
  - **Pattern:** repetition
- Kindergarten – Second Quarter:
  - **Color:** primary, secondary, tempera paint, watercolor paint, paintbrush
  - **Value:** light and dark
  - **Form:** three-dimensional shapes (solid), sculpture, clay, pinch pot
  - **Texture:** rough and smooth, collage
- Kindergarten – Third Quarter:
  - **Space:** Foreground, background and overlapping
