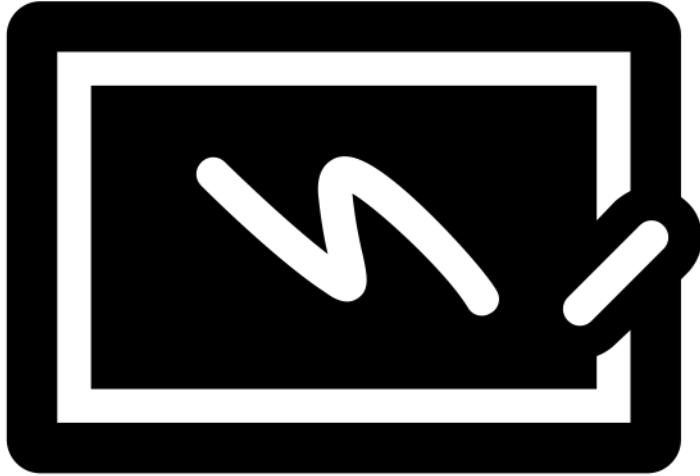
Why am I enrolled in ESY?

What's New this Summer?

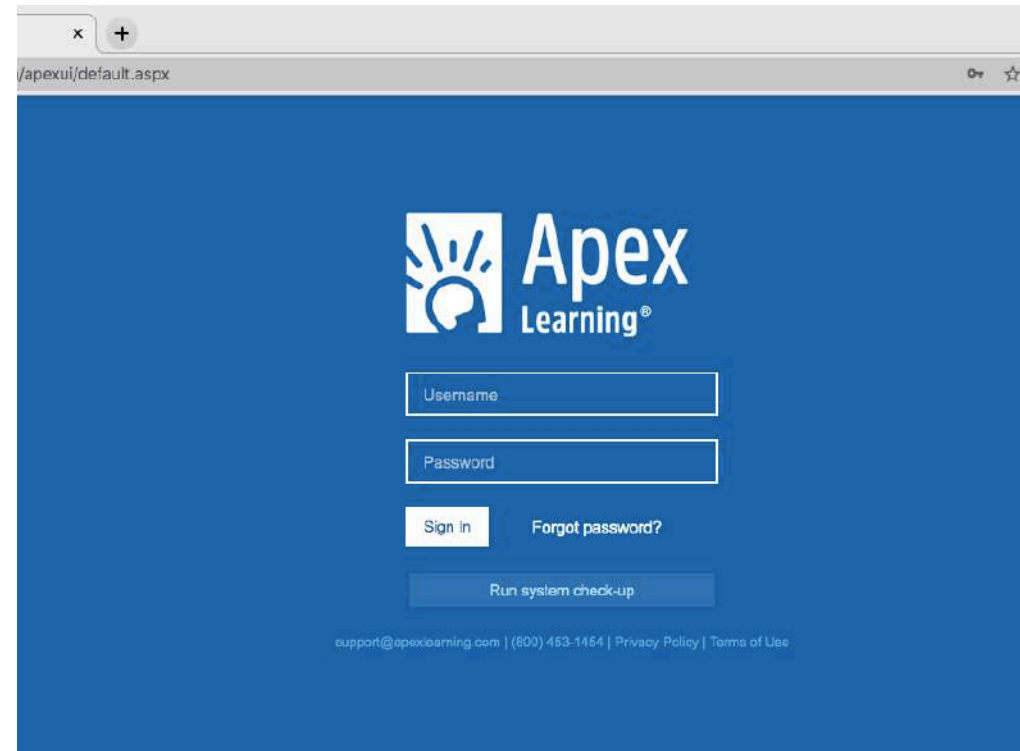
To maintain academic integrity and consistency:
