

# World Geography Europe Project

## Rubric

The World Geography Europe Project worked completed by November 11<sup>th</sup> 2016. Students are to choose a country in Europe and develop a unique way to present facts about this country to the class. The presentations will begin the week of November 14<sup>th</sup> and will be counted as a test grade.

### Directions

- Students will work in pairs or in groups of three selected. Students will be provided class time to work on the projects but it is expected that they utilize activity periods and/or out of school time to complete the assignment.
  - The students will need to cover 5 aspects of their country. A list of 12 aspects are provided below to choose from.
  - The presentation should be minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 10 minutes, followed by a short question/answer session with their peers providing the questions.
  - Some suggested methods to present the material are as follows:
    - Poster Board- must use color
    - Flip Book- must use color
    - 5 page research essay (you really don't want to do this)
    - Power Point- minimum 15 slides
    - All other options need to approved by Coach Dees
- Costumes, props, food, music and guests will be allowed.  
Additional ideas must be cleared through the teacher.

### **Country aspects to cover (choose 5)**

clothing	economy
religion	food
landforms and waterways	capitals and cities
language	government
climate	unique facts
unique country characteristics	traditions and customs

### Project Scoring

15 points – each country aspect (**5 aspects- 75 points**)  
10 points – knowledge of the country  
10 points – effort and preparation  
5 points - originality
