Expectations for Teacher-Directed Instruction

- ✓ Participate in the lesson after raising your hand and being called upon.
- ✓ Raise your hand and wait to be called upon.
- ✓ Listening to the teacher and students who are speaking; participating in the discussion by raising your hand and waiting to be called upon; taking notes or completing guided practice. Use ACTIVE LISTENING.
- ✓ Students must be seated at all times unless given permission to get up or move.
- ✓ Eyes on the speaker at all times and focus on instruction and/or resources being used.

Expectations for Transitions

- ✓ Conversation: None
- ✓ Help: Raise your hand and wait to be called upon.
- ✓ Activity: Listening to Mrs. Gleaton and following her directions. Quietly organizing previous activity's materials while gathering materials for new activity.
- ✓ Movement: Seated at all unless permission is given to move. If transition is lining up, wait to be called to line up and do so without talking or touching anyone or their items.
- ✓ Participation: Not moving until directions are complete.

Expectations for Independent Work

- ✓ Students should remain silent while working independently.
- ✓ When you need please raise your hand and wait for the teacher to help. While waiting go ahead to next question. Do not interrupt any of peers while they are working silently.
- ✓ Students must remain seated at all times unless permission is given to move.
- ✓ Students must remain on task and stay focus during independent work.

Expectations for Conferencing and Small Group Activities

- ✓ ALL students must participate in discussion with group members and contribution ideas. Clarify your learning and share products of your learning with your peers. All group members <u>must</u> contribute ideas and towards the groups' goal to a finish product.
- ✓ If you need help, please raise your hand and wait to be called upon. You may seek help from your group. Noise level must remain low.
- ✓ Students may sharpen their pencil or gather materials needed quietly without disturbing others.
