Dear Parents/Guardians:

The St. Johns County School District's high schools will be administering the PSAT/NMQST test to all 10th grade students (in Eng 2 for the first time), free of charge, on October 12, 2022. All students in 9th and 11th grades will have the opportunity to take the PSAT; however, they will be charged a fee of \$22.00 by their schools to receive their test scores.

Listed below are some reasons why your student should consider taking the PSAT/NMQST:

- Grade 10 pre-college testing provides a basis to increase college participation.
- The PSAT is an indicator for performance on the SAT.
- PSAT includes verbal, mathematics, and writing components; it is used as a diagnostic tool to measure strengths and weaknesses for both students and curriculum.
- The PSAT helps assess academic skills necessary for college-level work.

Any 10th grade parent that does not wish for their student to take the PSAT/NMQST test on October 12<sup>th</sup> must sign this letter and have the student return it to Mrs. Zapata in the Media Center prior to September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Gr. 10 students who do not return this form by 9/9/22 will take the PSAT10 on 10/12/22 during school hours.
