Dear Parents/Guardians:

The St. Johns County School District's high schools will be administering the PSAT/NMQST test to all 10th grade students (in Eng 2 for the first time), free of charge, on October 12, 2022. All students in 9th and 11th grades will have the opportunity to take the PSAT; however, they will be charged a fee of \$22.00 by their schools to receive their test scores.

Listed below are some reasons why your student should consider taking the PSAT/NMQST:

- Grade 10 pre-college testing provides a basis to increase college participation.
- The PSAT is an indicator for performance on the SAT.
- PSAT includes verbal, mathematics, and writing components; it is used as a diagnostic tool to measure strengths and weaknesses for both students and curriculum.
- The PSAT helps assess academic skills necessary for college-level work.

Any 10th grade parent that does not wish for their student to take the PSAT/NMQST test on October 12th must sign this letter and have the student return it to Mrs. Zapata in the Media Center prior to September 16th, 2022. Gr. 10 students who do not return this form by 9/9/22 will take the PSAT10 on 10/12/22 during school hours.
