IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT PTSO SCHOLARSHIP

Students of all active PTSO members are eligible to apply for the PTSO scholarship, provided they are graduating in May 2023 and became a member of the PTSO before November 1, 2022. Active membership is defined as volunteering at least six hours to PTSO causes during the current school year (attending meetings counts towards hours), to include hours completed by the student applying. The PTSO officers will meet during the second semester of the school year and will select a winner based on who best exhibits the following criteria: school leadership, school ambassador/steward, live the Leilehua values (leadership, humility, service), along with an outstanding application packet.
