Some of what our students enjoy...

Musical Theater: Our musical theater program includes instruction and performance opportunities in various productions throughout the year. Students learn technique in acting, singing and dancing while building confidence, learning teamwork and making new friends.



Acting: FAPA offers acting instruction through leveled classes and performance opportunities both in one act play presentations and collections of scenes and monologues. Younger students have fun with our imagination-based philosophy and older students are encouraged to dig deeper into a variety of acting techniques.



Improvisation: Our Improvisation program is so much fun kids often don't realize how much they're growing as performers and public speakers. Improvisation focuses on collaboration, empathy, and teamwork and provides life skills that translate both on stage and off.

Technical Theater & Design:

Not everyone who loves the performing arts wants to be ON stage. Students who are interested in the behind-the-scenes elements of theater enjoy our technical theater classes where kids get hands-on experience in lighting, sound, backstage and front of house management. We also offer classes in design aspects like stage make up and scenic design so students can study whatever elements interest them most.

Music Lessons & Classes: FAPA provides both small group and private lessons in a variety of disciplines. Piano, guitar, voice and even ukulele are among the focus of our programming. Studying music not only enriches kids' lives artistically, but has been shown to increase test scores and cognitive abilities.



Musical Theater Choreography:
