### 1. What classes do I need on my schedule?

### 2. Is HOPE required for graduation?

Yes, unless you plan to play 2 years of a FHSAA sport (JV or Varsity).

### 3. I took a high school class in middle school and I didn't do very well, can I retake it?

Yes, if you earned a C or below in a high school course we strongly encourage you to retake the course in high school, both to increase your skills and boost your GPA.

### 4. I didn't apply for an academy, can I still join?

\*Academies are 3 year programs of study, so you can re-apply next year.

\*Additionally, if you are interested in the VyStar or Building Construction Academy, you can take those introduction courses as general electives.

### 5. I didn't apply for IB, can I still get in?

Yes, you will need to talk with Mr. Higgins or Mrs. Toffaletti to review your eligibility.

### 6. Is previous theatre experience required to take the course in high school?

### 7. How many electives do I get?

As many as needed to fill 7 periods on your schedule.

### 8. Do I need 2 years of a World Language?

If you're going to college yes but you don't have to start freshmen year, we offer ASL and Spanish and there are other options online and you can't start in 9th grade unless in Honors or Pre IB ELA.

### 9. Why don't I have a social studies on my schedule?

Only 3 years of Social Studies are required to graduate, starting your sophomore year.
