

Frequently Asked Questions for TECE 1 and 2

Q: Is TECE 1 and 2 available separately, as two courses, in-person?

A: Yes, contact a program provider above to inquire about schedule.

Q: Is TECE 1 and 2 available separately, as two courses, online?

A: No, TECE 1 and 2 must be taken together as it is only offered as a complete training package of 120 hours.

Q: Can I take TECE 1 in person and then finish online or vice versa?

A: No, you must complete the 120 hours of coursework in the same program format.

Q: Which CDA credential “type” will be accepted for TECE 1 and 2?

A: Online training organizations often offer Infant/Toddler, Preschool and Family Child Care CDA credentials. All three of these credential types are accepted for TECE 1 and 2. Choose the program that fits best based on the children you plan to support.

Q: Am I able to finish online coursework that I started with Collaboration (Cypherworx)?

A: Because third party companies (not the Office of Early Learning) offer online TECE 1 and 2 coursework, professionals must speak directly with the company to learn all of the company’s policies. Note that TECE 1 & 2 training from Cypherworx/Collaboration is being phased out. This training will no longer be accepted after January 1, 2020.
