Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is a progress monitoring system that is administered three times per year to track your student’s progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) Standards throughout this school year. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that your student will participate in the third administration (PM3) of the following assessments on the dates listed:

The results from PM3 will show how well your student has mastered the grade level content standards, and you will be provided with a paper copy of the results shortly after testing is completed. You may also access results online through the Family Portal at <https://fl-familyportal.cambiumast.com/>. Please note, at this time it is uncertain how quickly the portal will be updated after testing. In order to log into the portal, you will need a unique 6-digit access code that can be found in HAC under the registration tab. It will be labeled as the statewide assessment access code. This code will consist of letters and numbers and is not the student ID number.

Your student’s FAST assessments are computer-adaptive tests taken on a computer or tablet. The questions get less or more difficult depending on how a student responds, and each student will see different questions.
