# ONLINE LEARNING DAYS

## October 6<sup>th</sup> & October 14<sup>th</sup>

### Tuesday, October 6<sup>th</sup> – Online Learning Day #1

- October 6<sup>th</sup> will be a “Synchronous” Online Learning Day for **9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> Grade** students – meaning that these students will be expected to attend their online classes in *real time*. **Attendance will be taken!**
- It will be an **Even Block Day** with online class sessions. Following are the start times for each period that day:

<b>9:00 AM</b>	<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Block</b>
<b>10:30 AM</b>	<b>Homeroom</b>
<b>1:00 PM</b>	<b>4<sup>th</sup> Block</b>
<b>2:30 PM</b>	<b>6<sup>th</sup> Block</b>
- For **12<sup>th</sup> Graders**, it will be an “Asynchronous” Online Learning Day – meaning that seniors must complete their classwork at some point *during the day*, but not at any specific time. (The reason for this is that we will have many seniors taking the ACT Exam that day.)

### Who Should Come to School on October 6<sup>th</sup>?

- **12<sup>th</sup> Graders** who have registered for the ACT must arrive at school no later than 8:15 AM and go, immediately, to their testing room. These will be posted. Seniors will be released from school upon completion of the ACT Exam.
- Students who attend **self-contained classes** should attend school that day, as normal.
- Students who **cannot** stay home due to family &/or technology circumstances. Online learning will be facilitated throughout the school, but students will NOT attend classes in their normal rooms. They will learn online in designated locations.

### **Wednesday, October 14<sup>th</sup> – Online Learning Day #2**

- October 14<sup>th</sup> will be a “Synchronous” Online Learning Day for 9<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade students – meaning that these students will be expected to attend their online classes in *real time*. **Attendance will be taken!**
- It will be an **Odd Block Day** with online class sessions. Following are the start times for each period that day:

<b>9:00 AM</b>	<b>1<sup>st</sup> Block</b>
<b>10:30 AM</b>	<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Block</b>
<b>1:00 PM</b>	<b>5<sup>th</sup> Block</b>
<b>2:30 PM</b>	<b>7<sup>th</sup> Block</b>
- For 10<sup>th</sup> graders, it will be an “Asynchronous” Online Learning Day – meaning that sophomores must complete their classwork at some point *during the day*, but not at any specific time. (The reason for this is that most 10<sup>th</sup> graders will be taking the PSAT Exam that day.)

#### **Who Should Come to School on October 14<sup>th</sup>?**

- **All 10<sup>th</sup> Graders** have been registered for the PSAT and should plan to attend on this day.
- **9<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> Graders** who have registered for the PSAT must arrive at school no later than 8:15 AM and go, immediately, to their testing room. These will be posted.
- With parental/guardian permission, students MAY leave school upon completion of the PSAT (approximately 12:30 PM). A link will be sent for parents/guardians to consent to early release.
  - Please note, buses will only run during normal times.
  - Students not permitted to leave early will learn in online learning centers throughout the school during the remainder of the day.
- Students who attend **self-contained classes** should attend school that day, as normal.
- Students who **cannot** stay home due to family &/or technology circumstances. Online learning will be facilitated throughout the school, but students will NOT attend classes in their normal rooms. They will learn online in designated locations.
