- It will be an **Odd Block Day** with online class sessions. Following are the start times for each period that day:

9:00 AM 1st Block 10:30 AM 3rd Block 1:00 PM 5th Block 2:30 PM 7th Block

• For **10**th **graders**, it will be an "Asynchronous" Online Learning Day – meaning that sophomores must complete their classwork at some point *during the day*, but not at any specific time. (The reason for this is that most **10**th graders will be taking the PSAT Exam that day.)

Who Should Come to School on October 14th?

- All 10th Graders have been registered for the PSAT and should plan to attend on this day.
- 9th & 11th Graders who have registered for the PSAT must arrive at school no later than 8:15 AM and go, immediately, to their testing room. These will be posted.
- With parental/guardian permission, students MAY leave school upon completion of the PSAT (approximately 12:30 PM). A link will be sent for parents/guardians to consent to early release.
 - Please note, buses will only run during normal times.
 - Students not permitted to leave early will learn in online learning centers throughout the school during the remainder of the day.
