



Join our family Code.org class and learn the fundamentals of computer science through games and fun activities you can play at home!

Here's how to join:

1. Create a family or parent Code.org account if you haven't already done so. Do not use your student's account (they already have one and use it – this should be your own or a family one). You can do this at https://studio.code.org/users/sign_up. You can either sign up with an email address and password, or sign up through Google, Facebook, or Microsoft by clicking on one of those buttons on the Code.org website
2. Sign in to you Code.org account. Remember your login credentials for next time.
3. Navigate to **<https://code.org/join>** and type in the section code: **DCZDXN**.
4. Once you press the "Go" button, you should be added to the section.
5. Once you join, the club leader will contact you to get started. You can participate at home with your family at any time you choose online and complete the online activities. We will also have the "unplugged" activities available for your participation at our family exploration academy nights throughout the year.
6. You can sign into your Code.org accounts by going to <https://code.org/> and clicking on the "Sign in" button on the top right corner.
