The month of February is nationally recognized as Black History Month. Hagerty High School has been celebrating black history all month around campus. Our main goal this month has been to create a print rich environment that showcases the many outstanding achievements by African- Americans in the history of our country. Next year, Hagerty will also offer a social studies elective course in African American history. The National Merit Finalists were also announced this past week! Hagerty High School is very proud of our ten National Merit Finalists! They are Nitin Balasubramanian, Aidan Burrowes, Emily Cobb, Hannah Connell, Kevin Connell, James Hu, Audrey Li, Rebecca Rollins, Sana Yooseph, and Kaleb Zhai. These students were part of a group of approximately 15,000 students nationwide who qualified as finalists based on their PSAT scores from their junior year. These students are now eligible to earn one of approximately 7,500 Merit Scholarships!

Finally, this year's senior class will have 180 Honor Grad students. To qualify as an Honor Grad, a student must have a 4.0 weighted GPA or higher. This group makes up almost 1/3 of our senior class! We will celebrate them on April 19th.
