Earn Jet Points

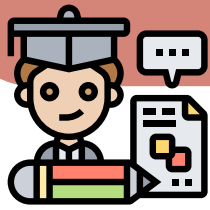
Is your little scholar counting down the days until the next Jet Jamboree? Let's rev up their excitement and help them score some sweet points to jam out at the big event!
