Hello Wildcat Families!

One of the most valuable tools that students can have when it comes to math is basic fact fluency. Math fact fluency is defined as having efficient, flexible and accurate methods for computing. Each grade level has different expectations for fact fluency by the end of the school year.

Kindergarten: addition and subtraction within 5
First Grade: addition and subtraction within 10
Second Grade: addition and subtraction within 20
Third Grade: multiplication and division within 100
Fourth Grade & Fifth Grade: Automaticity of multiplication and division within 100

Working with your child at home on their fact fluency is one of the best ways that you can support their math learning and growth. You can quiz your child in the car, practice skip counting or ask them to explain how they got their answer. There are many resources online or apps that are fun, yet helpful, in helping develop fact fluency. All you have to do is Google "Fact Fluency Games or Apps."

Morning Drop Off/Afternoon Pick Up - Friendly reminders

In order to make the arrival and dismissal time as safe as possible please adhere to the following reminders and timeline for parent pick up and dismissal.

Arrival Procedures (7:55-8:20)

8:20 - 1st bell rings.

- Double doors by the parent drop off loop close and will be locked.
- School personnel go inside.
- Students arriving after 8:25am will be walked into the office and signed in by an adult.

8:25 – 2nd bell rings. School day begins.

- It is against the law to text or talk on the phone in a school zone. This is also a safety concern for your children and our staff members who are supervising the PPU/DO process.
- Parents will be signaled by an Osceola staff member when it is time for children to exit the vehicle at <u>7:55</u>. Children should not exit the vehicle until signaled.
- Children should exit the vehicle from the passenger side of the car. This way staff and students are not in the lane with moving vehicles.
- The parent pick up lot will be locked at 8:25 each morning.
- If you arrive after 8:25, an adult will need to walk children to the front office.
 - Please do not allow children to walk into the building unescorted.
 - As you know, the front office has a buzzer button that children are not able to reach in order to alert staff that they are outside.
- If your PreK child is here after 8:20 you will take them to the front office where you will need to wait with them until PreK staff arrive to escort them to the classroom.
- If PreK students are not picked up by 2:40, you will pick them up from the office.
- Drivers should exercise safe driving habits when entering and exiting the Parent Pick Up lot.
- For afternoon pick up, student name tags should remain on the dashboard of the car until you have left the Parent Pick Up line.
- During afternoon pick up, PreK parents will move to the parking area or between the cones at the front of the parking lot while waiting for PreK siblings if they are not out when the second dismissal process begins.

Dismissal procedures (2:40-3:10)

- Use the parent pick up loop to pick up students.
- Parents remain in their cars to pick up children, otherwise they will be asked to report to the front office to check out their children.
