

## Feedback from Area F

	<b>Concerns</b>
<b>PPE / safety</b>	District must pay for ample and appropriate PPE – masks and gloves especially.
	Use and re-use of non-reusable materials or inferior/ineffective masks
	Won't be able to see students' mouths if covered – may make speech harder to understand or hear
	Students with diapers or in need of bathroom assistance – teacher or para are changing or cleaning
	Speech Language Pathologists need masks that allow their mouths to be seen.
	Who will be wearing masks? Teachers? Students? Students may not keep masks on.
	Will students have behavior consequences for not wearing masks?
	Option to work at home if in high-risk category or family member at risk
	What happens to students exhibiting symptoms? How will we sanitize when illness is discovered? Is there a quarantine plan and who would be required? Who will notify staff if a student or colleague is ill without HIPAA concerns but considering our safety? (also cleanliness concern)
	Will staff and / or students be tested prior to return to school?
<b>Cleanliness</b>	District must pay for cleaning materials Currently teachers/families supply tissues, wipes, Clorox wipes, hand sanitizer, paper towel.
	Sanitizing and cleaning classrooms
	Classrooms using rugs or group area for instruction – how will these be kept clean?
	Has building janitorial staff all been let go??? Teachers perceive this to be true

<b>Cleanliness (cont.)</b>	<b>Concerns (continued)</b>
	Extra person in each classroom to sanitize routinely and frequently throughout the day, eg. after each use of bathroom
	Bathrooms in classrooms – frequent cleaning throughout the day
	Staff bathrooms - frequent cleaning throughout the day
	Cleaning of doors and door handles, copiers - frequent cleaning throughout the day
	New cleaning procedures?
	Which materials are safe for sanitizing and will they be available to purchase?
	Who will be cleaning what? Are students and teachers cleaning? Many wipes are labeled not for children.
<b>Space</b>	Small group space concerns
	Number of students in room not conducive to social distancing
	Staff lounge space
	Common areas and recess – how to keep kids apart in halls, cafeteria, recess
	Entering building at staggered times to reduce contact?
	How will transportation support social distancing?
	Shared classrooms and split areas do not allow ample space
	Physical needs of some students requires one-on-one supervision
	Choice of in-school or remote schooling for both teachers and students (families)
<b>Furniture</b>	Individual desks for students (Kindergarten)
	Group tables and shared seating
<b>Accommodations, materials and other</b>	Speech especially concerned with airborne particulates while teaching and after – suggest a powerful fan, plexi-glass barrier
	Shared classroom supplies are not safe
	Staff in a high-risk group – how is this being addressed?
	Working in very close proximity in a very small space

Accomodations, materials and other (continued)	Concerns (continued)
	Computer equipment that is shared
	Books and other shared materials – are they going to be sanitized or quarantined? What is the best way to clean each type of item?
	Shared space like gym and music, library, art room, computer lab – how sanitizing between classes?
***	<b>Survey teachers to see who is planning / willing to return. Don't leave it until the last minute and then have insufficient staff for students in buildings. It is possible some staff will refuse to return for safety reasons.</b>
