Fivay High School Student Agreement

The following document represents an agreement between you, the student at Fivay High School, your parent/guardian, and Fivay High School. You and your parent **must** complete this form and turn it **prior to buying your ticket**.

Criteria for Purchasing Tickets

All Pasco County students must meet the following criteria to be eligible to purchase tickets and/or attend the dance:

- No less than a 2.0 gpa
- No more than 60 periods of unexcused absences for the 2nd semester
- No level three referrals

Entrance & Identification

Prom is on Saturday May 6th from 7:00 pm until 10:00 pm at the Soire Estates at SB Nursery and Gardens; 5710 Happy Tails Ln, Lutz Fl 33558. Tickets will NOT be sold at the door. All students and guests must be checked in by 7:45 PM. All dance participants MUST present either a school id or a government-issued id. There will be no exceptions whatsoever, even if school personnel at the event recognize you and/or your guest. There are NO REFUNDS and tickets are NOT eligible for re-sale.

No Re-Entry & Student Behavior

Once a student or guest enter the dance, they will not be permitted to leave and re-enter. Students will not be permitted to go their vehicles after entering the dance. All students and guests must follow the Code of Conduct and are subject to disciplinary consequences if the Code of Conduct is not followed. Upon reasonable suspicion, we reserve the right to search all cars, party busses, and limos, as well as purses and other belongings. Outside food and drink are not permitted. The use of tobacco products, drugs, and alcohol is NOT permitted. Students are prohibited from being in possession of any type of weapon, including any look alike weapon. FHS students are responsible for the conduct of his/her guest at all times. FHS students may be subject to disciplinary action based on the conduct of their guest. Any violation of school rules including inappropriate behavior may result in your immediate removal from the event and may result in disciplinary action, in accordance with school policy.

Dress Code

Gentleman: semi-formal is encouraged. Formal is acceptable. No muscle shirts, tank tops or shorts. All shirts must to be kept on. Ladies: semi-formal is encouraged. Formal is acceptable. Modest length, appropriately covering the chest. Comfortable shoes are encouraged. No short skirts or shorts. Attire must be at least school appropriate length and must stay down when walking or dancing.

Dance Floor Behavior

Age-appropriate dancing is expected. Inappropriate dancing will not be tolerated. This includes grinding, grind trains, bending over, straddling legs, lap dancing, etc. Inappropriate touching is also prohibited. Students who break this rule will be asked to stop. If students continue to break rules or are non-compliant, they will be required to leave, and parents will be contacted. The lights will be turned up and/or music changed as a collective warning for everyone. Appropriate dancing includes, hands on waist or shoulders only, both feet on the floor, and respectful public displays of affection. Any violation of school rules including inappropriate dancing will result in your immediate removal from the event and may result in disciplinary action, in accordance with school policy.

End of Dance Procedures

Students are not allowed to re-enter the dance upon leaving. Students must vacate the premises by 10:30 pm. Failure to be picked up from the dance within 30 minutes of its conclusion may cause suspension from future school activities. Make sure you have a ride waiting for you at the conclusion of the dance.

Student & Guest Responsibilities

It is the responsibility of you, the student or guest, to resolve any and all questions concerning any of the terms and conditions listed in this agreement prior to the date of the Homecoming Dance. If you and/or your guest fail to meet any of these terms or conditions listed in this agreement you understand that you and/or your guest will be required to leave the event and NO REFUND will be issued. All guests must comply with all school and district Code of Conduct requirements.

No refunds will be issued for any reason once tickets are purchased.
