Dear Parents:

We would like to remind you about our class field trip on May 9th, 2014. This letter contains the trip details and a list of supplies your child should bring along.

Seventh Grade Class Trip

Site	EPCOT Theme Park in Orlando, Florida
Date	May 9 th , 2014
Check-In Time	No later than 3:45 AM in school parking lot in the front of the school. Buses will leave at 4 :00 AM and we cannot wait on late students.
Return Time	Saturday, May 10 between 2:00 a.m. and 2:30 a.m.
Breakfast	Bring breakfast and snacks for the trip. We will not be stopping for breakfast.
Dress Code	Students will be allowed to wear shorts, including gym shorts, as long as they meet the 2 inch rule. We will NOT delay departure for dress code violations.
Recommended Amount for expenses	\$ 50.00 per student. Please keep in mind that simple things such as water cost between \$ 2.50- \$ 3.00. Also, students will receive two meal tickets. If students leave money behind, teachers will not be responsible for their expenses.
Supervision	One adult chaperone for each group of five/ six students.
Special Rules	>Students MUST stay with their assigned group, and are NEVER allowed to go off without an adult. > Remember that you will be representing DELTA and TCMS, and we expect you to be on your best behavior.
Note	Students are allowed to bring pillows, blankets and snack food on the bus. Beverages must have a screw on lid. Students are expected to clean after themselves and leave no trash on the bus. Teachers are not responsible for lost or damaged personal items.

Please make sure that your child brings the following items along on the trip:

- Cash for snacks and souvenirs.
- Backpack/ Gym bag for personal items, such as sunscreen, deodorant, etc.
- Snacks for the bus and breakfast.
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Comfortable shoes
- Writing utensil (for scavenger hunt)
- Water Bottle (there are water fountains in the park)
